Adoration and Praise

Adoration and praise are essential aspects of Christian prayer and worship. It is the act of giving honor, glory, and praise to God for who He is and what He has done. Through adoration and praise, we express our gratitude, awe, and reverence to God for His majesty, power, and love. Adoration and praise involve focusing on God's attributes, character, and actions as revealed in Scripture and recognizing that He alone is worthy of our worship and devotion. Adoration and praise are not just a ritual, but a way of life that reflects our deep love and devotion to our Creator and Redeemer.

- **Adoration of God's Holiness:**

- Adoration of God's Power:

O Mighty God, Your power is beyond measure, and there is nothing that can stand against You. Your arm is not too short to save, nor is Your ear too dull to hear. You have defeated the powers of darkness, and overcome the world. I praise You for Your limitless power, and for Your willingness to use it for my good.

- Adoration of God's Wisdom:

O God of wisdom, Your ways are higher than my ways, and Your thoughts are beyond my comprehension. You have infinite knowledge, and Your understanding is without limit. I praise You for Your wisdom, and for the guidance that You offer me in all things. Teach me to trust in Your wisdom, and to seek Your counsel in all that I do.

- Adoration of God's Love:

O God of love, Your love for me is greater than I can ever imagine. You have loved me with an everlasting love, and have shown me the depths of Your grace. I praise You for Your unfailing love, and for the way that You have shown it to me in Jesus Christ. Help me to love others as You have loved me.

- Adoration of God's Creativity:

O God of beauty, Your creativity is evident in all of creation. You have spoken the world into existence, and have filled it with

wonders and marvels. I praise You for Your artistic handiwork, and for the way that You reveal Your glory through the beauty of Your creation. May my life be a reflection of Your creativity and splendor.

- Adoration of God's Immutability:

O God of constancy, You are the same yesterday, today, and forever. Your faithfulness endures through all generations, and Your love never fails. I praise You for Your unchanging nature, and for the way that You remain constant in a world that is always changing. May I find my security in You, and may Your immutability be a source of strength and hope in my life.

- Adoration of God's Glory:

O Lord, how majestic is Your name in all the earth! You have created all things by the word of Your power, and in You, all things hold together. Your glory is beyond measure, and Your wisdom is unsearchable.

From the splendor of Your holiness, You have revealed Yourself in creation, displaying Your glory and power for all to see. Your works are marvelous, and Your ways are past finding out.

Lord, You are the light that shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. You have sent Your Son, Jesus Christ, to reveal Your glory to the world, and in Him, we see Your grace and truth.

Help us, O Lord, to adore Your glory with all our heart, mind, soul, and strength. May we worship You in spirit and in truth, as we behold Your glory and are transformed into Your image.

Personal Spiritual Growth

Praying for personal spiritual growth is the act of seeking to deepen our relationship with God and to become more like Christ. This category encompasses various subcategories such as the pursuit of holiness, the fleeing of pride, deliverance from sin, and the cultivation of spiritual disciplines. By focusing on personal spiritual growth, we recognize our need for continual transformation and renewal by the Holy Spirit. We pray for God's guidance and wisdom, and we ask for His grace and strength to walk in obedience to His will. Our aim is to be transformed into the image of Christ, to grow in our love for God and others, and to bear fruit that glorifies Him.

Pray through the the categories below:

Submission to God's Providence

Submission to God's providence is the acknowledgement that God is sovereign and in control of all things, including the circumstances and events of our lives. It is recognizing that God's ways are higher than our ways, and that He has a purpose and plan for each of us that is ultimately for our good and His glory. Praying for submission to God's providence means asking for the grace to trust Him completely, even in the midst of trials, suffering, or uncertainty. It involves surrendering our will and desires to His will and trusting that His plan for our lives is perfect and good. Through prayer, we can ask God to help us embrace His providence, to see His hand at work in all situations, and to have a heart that is content with whatever He brings into our lives.

- Delighting and being satisfied in God's will
 - "Lord, help me to find joy and contentment in following Your will, even when it's difficult or uncomfortable. Give me a heart that desires Your will above my own, and help me to trust in Your goodness and faithfulness."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Being a sensible steward of money, time, work, people, joy, and suffering
 - "Lord, teach me to use the resources and opportunities You've given me wisely and for Your glory. Help me to be a faithful and generous steward of all that You've entrusted to me."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Never complaining about circumstances
 - "Father, give me the grace to accept and embrace whatever circumstances come my way. Help me to find joy and contentment in You, even when things are hard."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Having no fear of bad news
 - "Lord, help me to trust in Your goodness and faithfulness, even in the midst of difficult news or circumstances. Give me peace and confidence in You."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying for peace, calm, fortitude, and resignation to God's future plans
 - "Father, help me to trust in Your plans and to find peace and rest in You. Give me the courage and strength to face whatever comes my way, knowing that You are with me."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying for freedom from sin and prideful tendencies

- "Lord, free me from the power and grip of sin in my life. Help me to resist temptation and to pursue righteousness and purity. Give me humility and a heart that is quick to confess and repent of sin."
- Other things in this category to pray for:
- Spiritual qualities
 - Praying for the development and cultivation of various spiritual qualities, such as meekness, gentleness, self-denial, poverty of spirit, mourning for sin, hungering and thirsting after righteousness, mercy and compassion, purity of heart, honesty and simplicity of spirit, readiness to undergo and to forgive injuries, zeal for God, contempt for the world, love for enemies, and fear of sinning and of God's judgments for sin.

Personal Holiness

This category is focused on the desire and commitment to grow in Christlikeness. It involves acknowledging our weaknesses and sinful tendencies, and asking God to transform us by His grace and power. This category includes prayers for the Holy Spirit's guidance, conviction of sin, and strengthening of our faith. It also includes prayers for specific areas where we struggle with temptation or fail to obey God's commands. Ultimately, the goal of praying for personal holiness is to become more like Jesus in our thoughts, attitudes, and actions, and to bring glory to God in all aspects of our lives.

- Single-minded devotedness
 - "Lord, help me to have a single-minded devotion to You, to seek first Your kingdom and righteousness, and to love You with all my heart, mind, soul, and strength."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Weaned from worldly vanities

- "Lord, help me to be weaned from the vanities and distractions of this world, and to set my mind on things above. Help me to live with an eternal perspective and to prioritize the things that matter most."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Undivided allegiance to God
 - "Father, help me to have an undivided allegiance to You, to resist the temptation to love the world or to seek the approval of others. Help me to be faithful to You above all else."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Cultivate in my heart an ever-increasing delight in Your person and Law
 - "Lord, help me to cultivate a heart that delights in You and in Your Word. Help me to find joy and satisfaction in knowing You and in following Your ways."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Cultivate in me the habit of being one Mind with You Lord
 - "Father, help me to have the same mind that You have, to agree with Your judgment in all things, and to measure everything in this world by the standard of Your Word."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Lord make it my food and drink to do Your will
 - "Lord, help me to have a heart that is eager to do Your will, to deny myself like Jesus did in order to minister to others. Help me to be meek and patient under undeserved insults and to think highly of others."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Lord make me bold and uncompromising in renouncing all sin in my life

- "Lord, give me the courage and strength to renounce all sin in my life, to seek not the praise of men, and to live in a way that is pleasing to You."
- Other things in this category to pray for:
- My heart is often cold toward others
 - "Lord, give me a spirit of mercy and benevolence toward all people, to lessen the spiritual wants and misery around me, and to be useful among men."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

Deliverance from Sin

This category refers to the process of asking God for help in overcoming the power of sin in our lives. Sin is a pervasive force that can control our thoughts, words, and actions, leading us away from God's plan and purpose for our lives. By recognizing our own weakness and inability to overcome sin on our own, we turn to God in prayer and ask for His power to break the chains of sin in our lives. This category of prayer can involve confession of specific sins, asking for forgiveness, and seeking God's help in developing spiritual disciplines that will help us to grow in holiness and righteousness. Ultimately, deliverance from sin is a process of transformation, as we allow the Holy Spirit to renew our minds and hearts and empower us to live a life that is pleasing to God.

- Remove all worldly fear and greed from me, Lord
 - "Lord, help me to turn away from the love of this world and to seek first Your kingdom and righteousness. Remove from me all fear and greed that hinders my relationship with You."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Strengthen me to depart from self-love, idolatry, and the pursuit of vain things
 - "Lord, give me the strength and desire to depart from all sin, to turn away from self-love, idolatry, and the pursuit of vain things, and to replace them with a growing delight in obeying and submitting to Your perfect will."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Help me to shun every known sin and to keep every known commandment
 - "Lord, help me to have a decided bent of mind toward You, to have a robust desire to do Your will and to shun every known sin. Give me a greater fear of displeasing You than of displeasing this world and a love for all Your ways."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Praying for the development and cultivation of a delight in the Law of God
 - "Lord, help me to delight in Your Law after the inward man, to treasure Your Word and to meditate on it day and night. Give me a heart that desires to obey You and to keep Your commandments."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Sensibility of my own weakness and impotence to do any good thing without God's help
 - "Lord, help me to be completely and utterly sensible of my own weakness and impotence to do any good thing without Your help. Teach me to depend on You for all good gifts and to trust in Your strength and guidance."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

Use of Time for Gospel

This category refers to the intentional and purposeful use of our time to share the Gospel with others and to advance the Kingdom of God. It involves being aware of the opportunities and openings that arise in our daily lives to share the Gospel, to encourage fellow believers, and to be a witness to those who do not yet know Christ. This can include engaging in evangelism efforts, participating in outreach programs, volunteering in the church and community, and intentionally building relationships with non-believers. The use of our time for the Gospel requires a commitment to putting the needs of others before our own, and a willingness to sacrifice our own desires and comforts for the sake of the Gospel. It is a recognition that our time is a valuable resource that can be used to bring glory to God and to advance His purposes in the world.

- Lord, utilize the time I have here on earth for the furtherance of Your kingdom
 - "Lord, help me to use my time on earth wisely and for the furtherance of Your kingdom. Show me how to prioritize my time and how to invest it in the things that matter most to You."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying for divine appointments and opportunities to share the gospel
 - "Lord, direct me towards people I can be a friend to for mutual encouragement and sharpening, as well as other friends who need to hear the gospel. Help me to be sensitive to Your leading and to be bold in sharing Your message of salvation."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying for success in spreading the gospel
 - "Lord, raise up Your people among the lost and bring success to Your gospel that men might see their need and

heed its message. Help me to be faithful in sowing the seed, trusting that You will bring the increase."

- Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying for preparation and equipping for ministry
 - "Lord, prepare and equip me through studies and daily preparation for ministry to others. Bless my efforts to learn and to grow in knowledge of You, that Your kingdom may be advanced and Your name might be glorified among the nations."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying for health and strength to live with all of my might for the gospel
 - "Lord, grant me health and strength to live with all of my might for the sake of the gospel. Help me to exert great effort in bringing the gospel to the lost and to leave the results in Your hands. Forgive me when I have woefully fallen short in this area."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

Flee Pride

The category is a call to recognize and combat the sin of pride, which is a tendency to place oneself above others or above God. This category emphasizes the importance of humility, which is the opposite of pride, and involves acknowledging our dependence on God and our need for His grace. By recognizing our own limitations and weaknesses, we can cultivate a spirit of humility and avoid the temptation to exalt ourselves above others. Prayers in this category may include asking God for help in identifying and overcoming prideful thoughts and behaviors, as well as seeking His grace to cultivate a spirit of humility and gratitude in our daily lives.

- Praying for grace to flee spiritual pride and seek a humble heart
 - "Lord, give me grace to flee spiritual pride and to seek a humble heart, which alone is acceptable to You. Help me to remember that every good gift is from above and that I have nothing that I did not receive."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Praying to keep a right perspective on faith and salvation
 - "Lord, help me to remember that even faith itself is a gift, and that Your grace, not my faith, sets me apart from others. Help me to keep this ever before me and to never feel superior to anyone, but always be generous in my judgments."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Praying to look to Christ's blood as the cause of salvation
 - "Lord, help me to look to Christ's blood as the cause of my salvation, and to never consider myself better than anyone else. Fill me with love and meekness toward all men that they might see You in me."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Praying for a servant heart
 - "Lord, grant me a servant heart and help me to delight in serving others for Your sake. May I never think meanly of others but rather consider others better than myself."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Praying to live in such a way that we would not be ashamed in the last hour of our lives
 - "Lord, help me to live in such a way that I would not do anything I would be afraid to do in the last hour of my life. Show me how I can bring You the most glory while I am here on earth."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

Charity

Charity, also known as *hesed* in Hebrew, is the quality of loving-kindness and benevolence towards others. It is a selfless act of giving to those in need without expecting anything in return. In the Bible, *hesed* is used to describe God's steadfast love and faithfulness towards his people. As followers of Christ, we are called to imitate this love and extend charity towards our fellow human beings. Praying for charity involves asking God to help us love others sacrificially, to be generous in our giving, and to have compassion and empathy towards those in need. It also involves seeking opportunities to serve and care for others, both within our community and beyond. Through charity, we can demonstrate the love of Christ to those around us and bring hope and healing to a hurting world.

- Praying for a heart of charity, big-heartedness, giving, and compassion
 - "Lord, grant me a heart of charity, big-heartedness, giving, and compassion toward others. Bring to mind a specific act of charity I can do to help others. May my home be open to all, and may I have fewer inhibitions towards the sons of men."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying for better discipline in prayer and studying God's Word
 - "Lord, help me to have better discipline in prayer and studying Your self-revelation in the Scriptures. Help me to excel still more in understanding You in knowledge and devotion as Your son."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying to hold our tongue and to be humble

- "Lord, help me to hold my tongue and to never speak ill of anybody, but only that which is fully honoring to them. Help me to have great personal humility and to always be sensible of my own faults."
- Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying to be honest and less hypocritical in all dealings
 - "Lord, put a greater fear of You in me that I would be more honest and less hypocritical in all my dealings. Help me to be a person of integrity and to always seek to do what is right and just."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Praying for instruction in the way chosen for us
 - "Lord, as it says in the Psalms, 'Who then is the man who fears the Lord? He will instruct him in the way chosen for him.' Help me to fear You and to seek Your instruction in the way You have chosen for me."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

Pray through Actions in Romans 12

This category is centered on praying through specific actions and attitudes that Christians are called to practice in Romans 12. In this chapter, the apostle Paul lays out several practical guidelines for Christian living, including the use of spiritual gifts, sincere love, hospitality, empathy, peace-making, and overcoming evil with good.

- Love sincerely and be devoted to one another in brotherly love
 - "Lord, help me to love sincerely and be devoted to others in brotherly love. May I put their needs above my own and seek to honor them as You would."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

- Share with those in need and bless those who persecute you
 - "Lord, help me to be generous and share with those in need. Give me a heart to bless those who persecute me, and to rejoice with those who rejoice and mourn with those who mourn."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Live in harmony with one another and do not repay evil for evil
 - "Lord, help me to live in harmony with others and to not repay evil for evil. Teach me to seek peace with everyone and to overcome evil with good."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Seek to honor others above self and do not seek revenge
 - "Lord, help me to honor others above myself and to not seek revenge. Give me a heart to serve and bless others, and to trust You to take care of any wrongs done to me."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Pray for eyes to see and ears to hear
 - "Lord, grant me eyes to see and ears to hear as You do. Help me to discern Your will and to follow it faithfully."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Pray for a willingness to be worn out in God's labors
 - "Lord, grant me a spirit which is willing to give heart, soul, body, and mind to be worn out in Your labors as You see fit. Use me as an instrument to bring about Your glory."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Pray for perseverance and delight in obedience
 - "Lord, teach me to persist even in the face of failure. Grant me perseverance in faith and in daily duties. Help me to delight in obedience to You and to find it sweet to pray and do Your will, even if it means suffering for Your cause."

- Other things in this category to pray for:
- Pray for holiness through sufferings
 - "Lord, help me to see my sufferings as Your school to make me more like Jesus and to make me holy for future serviceableness to the cause of Christ. Use me for Your glory, even in the midst of trials and sufferings."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:

Spiritual Qualities

The category "Spiritual Qualities" refers to a set of Christian virtues that believers are called to develop and exhibit in their lives. These virtues include meekness, gentleness, self-denial, poverty of spirit, mourning for sin, hungering and thirsting after righteousness, mercy and compassion, purity of heart, honesty and simplicity of spirit, readiness to undergo and to forgive injuries, zeal for God, contempt for the world, love for enemies, fear of sinning, and fear of God's judgments for sin. These spiritual qualities are not something that can be developed through sheer willpower, but rather through the work of the Holy Spirit in the believer's life. As Christians seek to grow in these virtues, they become more Christlike and more effective in serving God and others.

- Meekness
 - "Lord, help me to cultivate a meek and humble spirit, one that is not easily provoked or proud. Teach me to be gentle and patient with others, just as You are with me."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Gentleness
 - "Lord, help me to be gentle and kind with others, to show Your love and mercy to all. Give me a heart to forgive and to serve others in humility and grace."

- Other things in this category to pray for:
- Self-denial
 - "Lord, help me to deny myself, take up my cross, and follow You. Teach me to put aside my own desires and ambitions, and to seek Your will above all else."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Poverty of spirit
 - "Lord, help me to recognize my own spiritual poverty, that I am nothing without You. Give me a heart to depend on You completely, and to trust in Your provision and grace."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Mourning for sin
 - "Lord, help me to mourn for my sins and to turn away from them. Give me a heart to confess my sins to You and to seek Your forgiveness and cleansing."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Hungering and thirsting after righteousness
 - "Lord, help me to hunger and thirst after righteousness, to seek You above all else. Give me a heart to pursue holiness and to desire to be more like You."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Mercy and compassion
 - "Lord, help me to show mercy and compassion to others, just as You have shown to me. Give me a heart to love others as You do, and to extend grace and forgiveness to those who have wronged me."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Purity of heart
 - "Lord, create in me a pure heart and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Help me to guard my heart and to keep it

focused on You, so that my thoughts, words, and actions may be pleasing to You."

- Other things in this category to pray for:
- Honesty and simplicity of spirit
 - "Lord, help me to be honest and straightforward in all my dealings, to live with integrity and simplicity of heart. Teach me to avoid deceit and hypocrisy, and to be true to You and to others."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Readiness to undergo and to forgive injuries
 - "Lord, give me a heart to endure hardships and to forgive those who have hurt me. Help me to trust in Your sovereignty and to rely on Your grace, even in difficult times."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Zeal for God
 - "Lord, give me a burning passion and zeal for You and Your kingdom. Help me to serve You with all my heart, soul, mind, and strength, and to be a faithful witness to Your love and grace."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Contempt for the world
 - "Lord, help me to see this world for what it is, a passing shadow, and to set my heart and mind on things above. Teach me to be content in You, and to find my joy and satisfaction in Your presence."
 - Other things in this category to pray for:
- Love (not merely tolerance) for enemies
 - "Lord, help me to love my enemies, to pray for those who persecute me."

Intercession

Intercession is a form of prayer that involves bringing the needs and concerns of others before God. It's an act of love and compassion for those around us, as we ask God to intervene on their behalf, to provide for their needs, to protect them from harm, to bring healing and restoration, and to reveal His truth and grace to them. Intercession can be done individually or as a group, and it's a powerful way to express our care and concern for those in our families, churches, communities, and even for those we've never met around the world. Intercession is also a way to align our hearts with God's heart, to seek His will for the world and to participate in His work of bringing redemption and reconciliation to all people. Through intercession, we can be agents of God's mercy and grace, and we can experience the joy of seeing God at work in the lives of those around us.

The following categories are focused on prayers for our loved ones, acquaintances, church, nation, the world, and those who are lost.

- Family: Pray for their physical and spiritual needs, for their protection and safety, for their relationships with one another and with God, for their growth in faith and obedience, for their salvation if they're not yet believers.
 - Spiritual growth: Pray that each member of the family would grow in their relationship with God, reading and obeying His word, and sharing their faith with others.
 - Relationships: Pray that each family member would have healthy and loving relationships with one another, and that any conflicts or divisions would be resolved with grace and forgiveness.
 - Physical health and safety: Pray for the physical health and safety of each family member, that they would be protected

from harm and illness.

- Emotional well-being: Pray that each family member would have emotional stability and mental health, and that any struggles with anxiety, depression, or other mental health issues would be addressed with the right resources and support.
 - Financial provision: Pray for God's provision in meeting the financial needs of the family, that they would have enough to live on and even be able to give generously to others in need.
 - Wisdom and discernment: Pray that each family member would have wisdom and discernment in making decisions, both big and small, and that they would seek God's guidance in all things.
 - Protection from evil: Pray that each family member would be protected from the schemes of the enemy, and that they would be equipped with the spiritual armor of God to stand firm against any attacks.
 - Unity and love: Pray that the family would be united in love and purpose, and that they would serve one another with humility and joy.
 - Future plans: Pray for God's guidance and direction for the future plans of each family member, that they would follow His will and purposes for their lives.
 - Salvation: Pray for any family members who have not yet received Jesus as their Savior, that they would come to know Him and experience His love and forgiveness.
- Other things in this category to pray for my family:

- Friends & Neighbors: Pray for their salvation and spiritual growth, for their health and well-being, for their relationships, for their financial needs, for their work or studies, for their struggles and challenges.
 - Salvation: Pray that they would come to know Christ and experience salvation through Him.

- Spiritual growth: Pray that they would grow in their faith and knowledge of God, that they would develop a hunger for His Word and a desire to live for Him.
- Relationships: Pray that their relationships with others would be healthy and fruitful, that they would be surrounded by positive influences and supportive friends.
- Provision: Pray that they would have all their physical and material needs met, that they would be blessed with good health, financial stability, and security.
- Opportunities: Pray that they would have opportunities to use their gifts and talents for God's glory, that they would find fulfillment and purpose in their work and other activities.
- Protection: Pray that they would be protected from harm and danger, that God would keep them safe from accidents, illness, and other forms of harm.
- Guidance: Pray that they would seek God's will and direction in all areas of their lives, that they would make wise decisions and avoid any pitfalls or traps that would lead them astray.
- Comfort: Pray that they would experience God's comfort and peace in times of hardship, that they would find solace in His presence and in the support of their friends and family.
- Mission: Pray that they would be used by God to impact their communities and the world around them, that they would be His hands and feet to those in need, and that they would live out their faith in practical and tangible ways.
- Joy: Pray that they would experience the joy that comes from knowing and serving God, that they would find happiness and contentment in their lives, and that they would radiate that joy to others.

Other things in this category to pray for my friends and neighbors:

- Church: Pray for the leaders and members of your local church, for their unity and harmony, for their love and service toward one another, for their outreach and witness to the community, for their financial and material needs, for their spiritual growth and renewal.
 - Pray for our pastor, elders, and deacons to have wisdom and guidance from God as they lead our church.
 - Pray for our worship services to be pleasing and honoring to God, with sound biblical teaching and acceptable worship.
 - Pray for unity among our church members, that we would show practical love for one another and welcome newcomers with the love of Christ.
 - Pray for the spiritual growth of specific members in our church (choose a few from your church directory) and for opportunities to get to know them better.
 - Pray for any individuals in our church who have specific spiritual or physical needs, and ask God to provide for them.
 - Pray for the development of new friendships within our church, and for opportunities to get to know people we haven't met before.
 - Pray for the salvation of many lost souls in our city, and that our church would be effective in reaching them with the gospel.
 - Pray for those who are new to our church, that they would feel welcomed and nurtured into the family of God.
 - Pray for opportunities to practice hospitality towards members and visitors, and that our homes would be a place of blessing and ministry.

- Nation: Pray for your country's leaders, for their wisdom and integrity, for their justice and righteousness, for their protection and safety, for their adherence to the rule of law, for their policies and decisions that affect the well-being of the people, for

their relations with other nations.

Other things in this category to pray for:

- World: Pray for the global church, for its witness and impact in the world, for its growth and unity, for its protection and safety, for its leaders and workers, for its financial and material needs, for its response to the challenges and crises of our time.

Other things in this category to pray for:

- Lost souls: Pray for the salvation of those in yur life who don't know Christ, for their conviction of sin and repentance, for their faith and trust in Jesus, for their spiritual growth and discipleship, for their protection and safety, for their relationships with believers and non-believers.

Other things in this category to pray for:

As we come to the end of this prayer list, I want to encourage you to persevere in prayer. Remember that prayer is not just a list of requests we present to God, but a conversation with our loving Heavenly Father. He desires for us to draw near to Him, to pour out our hearts before Him, and to seek His face.

Don't be discouraged if you don't see immediate answers to your prayers. Sometimes God answers our prayers in ways we don't expect or in His own timing. But be assured that He hears and cares for every one of your concerns.

So continue to come before God in prayer, with faith and perseverance, trusting in His goodness and faithfulness. Let us press on in prayer, knowing that it is a powerful weapon in our spiritual

warfare, and a means of experiencing the presence and power of God in our lives.

May the Lord bless you and keep you, and may His face shine upon you as you seek Him in prayer.
